Suzanne Knight, MBA, MA, is an award-winning expert, keynote, and TEDx speaker, renowned for injecting humour, storytelling, and practical advice on topics including leading and navigating transformational change, the future of work, and cutting-edge technologies such as artificial intelligence, virtual and augmented reality, and the metaverse.

With a distinguished career as a global consultant and corporate executive, Suzanne has guided over 60 companies in 14 countries to anticipate and adapt to change so they can thrive, rather than just survive. As an instructor at York University's Schulich ExecEd business school, she has been imparting knowledge on change management, leadership, and communicating for impact for over a decade.

Suzanne's inspiring TEDx talk, "How to Juggle 10 Balls at the Same Time," leveraged her corporate transformation experience to help women, parents, and anyone struggling with their schedule embrace agility to be happier, achieve balance, and flourish as an individuals or family.

In 2023, Suzanne co-founded Be Uninterrupted, a social impact organization that uses AI and human connection to help professional women avoid or navigate career interruptions. Her goal is to solve for pay and gender equality, one woman at a time. In her corporate life, Suzanne was an Executive Advisor for Walmart Canada's Women in Retail program and developed the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging Strategy for a Consumer Goods company for their staff in North and Latin America.

Before embarking on her portfolio career, Suzanne held significant executive leadership roles: Vice President of Transformation Services for Walmart Canada, overseeing a portfolio affecting over 100,000 employees, Head of Organizational Effectiveness and Change at Philip Morris International (Canada), Deputy Head of Deloitte's Transformational Change consulting practice, and leader of the Modernizing Services portfolio for the Ontario government.

Suzanne holds an MA in Industrial/Organizational Psychology and an MBA in Finance and Strategy. Her contributions and impact have been widely recognized, with accolades such as being named on The Peak's Emerging Leaders List (under age 40) and Digital Media Zone's 2023 Women of the Year.
